## BOOK LAUNCH EVENT & PRIZE DISTRIBUTION OF STUDENTS' WEEK PROGRAM

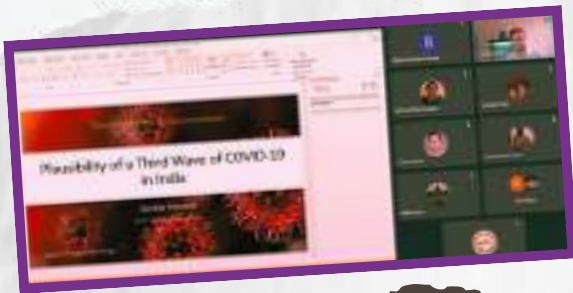

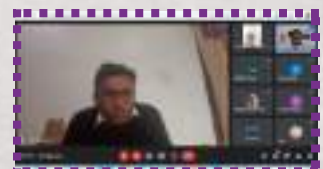
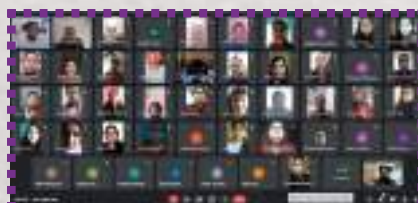


One painting of the college building has been done and gifted by the trainees .
