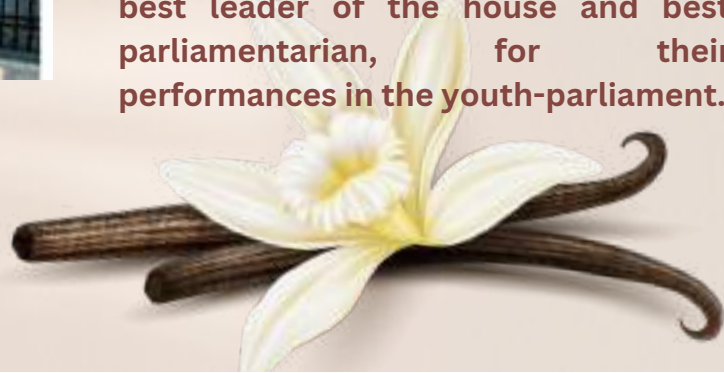


RABINDRA-BHANU SHRADDHANJALI 8TH AUGUST, 2019

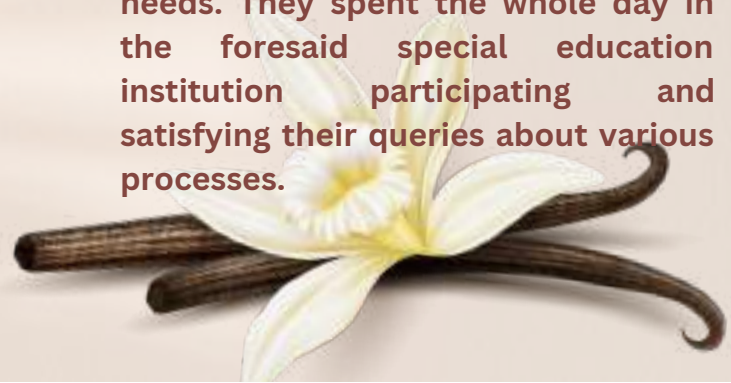


INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY 21ST FEBRUARY, 2020
