

Admission Rules for B.Ed. Course

Admission Rules for B.Ed. under BSAEU

for the Session 2023-2025

1. Medium of instructions: Bengali/ English
2. The B.Ed. programme shall be of duration of two academic sessions, which can be completed in a maximum of three years from the date of admission to the programme (as per the BSAEU Regulations)
3. **Admission will be as per Govt. order no. 372-EDN(CS)/10 M-20/2015 dated 08/06/2023**

4. Total Seats: 50

The total number of seats are 50 (Deputed candidates 5% and the rest of the total are Fresher candidates).

If deputed seat lies vacant due to the unavailability of deputed candidates that will be filled by fresher candidates obeying the reservation rules. The candidates are requested to follow “Subject and Category wise Distribution of Seats” that will be uploaded later.

Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PH candidates shall be as per West Bengal Government rules.

5. A. Eligibility: (The eligibility must be read with the three notes given below.)

In compliance with the NCTE norm.

- Candidates should be **Graduates in a school subject from** a recognized university.
- Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor’s Degree (General) / or in the Master’s Degree in **School subjects** are eligible to apply.
- Bachelor’s in Engineering or Technology with Science and/or Mathematics, with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are also eligible for admission. **Such candidates are required to enter the marks of B.E/ B. Tech. in the row of Honours Degree. M.E. / M. Tech result (if any) will be entered in the Master’s Degree row.**
- *Relaxation (in compliance with Govt. Order) regarding above:* Only for Fresher and Deputed SC/ST Candidates 5% relaxation of marks in UG or PG level is permissible.

- **Age bar:**
 - Fresher candidates can apply as per Govt. Rules.
 - The admission of Deputed Candidates is maintained by Govt. Rules
- **Teaching experience (applicable for deputed candidates only)**
 - Deputed candidates having at least 1 year of experience in Govt. Aided,/ Govt. Sponsored Schools can apply.
 - Deputed candidates must produce original MC/GB Permission, Approval, and NOC at the time of Counseling.

Note 1: School subjects of teaching offered are those which have been stated in the New Curriculum of BSAEU, the affiliating university)

Note2: Available infrastructure allows offering method subjects as given below.

(1) Bengali (2)English (3)History (4)Physical Science (5)Life Science (6) Geography (7)Mathematics.

- **Note 3: Accordingly,**
Fresher Candidates must have an Honours degree in any of the above-mentioned school subjects

Or

Fresher Candidates must have studied one of the above-mentioned school subjects with a minimum of 300 Marks as pass or Subsidiary or General subject in graduation level.

[Example-1: If a candidate had History or Geography in the pass course while doing honors in Philosophy or Political Science and later have completed Post Graduate in Philosophy or Political Science then he/she will be eligible for Pedagogy of History or Geography and ***will be treated as a Pass Graduate***. It is to be mentioned ***that the PG degree will not be considered here for scoring.***

Example-2: If a candidate had not studied History or Geography in the pass course while doing honors in Philosophy or Political Science and later completed Post Graduation in Philosophy or Political Science then ***he/she will not be able to apply for B. Ed. Admission to our college.***

Example-3: If a candidate had not studied History or Geography in the pass course while doing honors in Philosophy or Political Science and then has done Post Graduate in History or Geography then he/she will be able to apply for B. Ed. Admission ***as pass graduate with PG.***

6. Merit list:

- For *fresher candidates*, a merit list will be prepared separately for each school subject based on scoring.
- For *Deputed Candidates*, a merit list will be prepared separately for each school subject based on length of service.

7. Entry of marks for Scoring :

- M.P.: Put the aggregate of total marks (**Best Five**) **excluding** the additional subjects.
- H.S.: Calculate the aggregate of total marks (**Best Four**) **including** the additional subjects.
- Honours Graduates in school subject should enter the Honours marks only in the row of Bachelor's degree (Honours). *To get the full marks for **Honours subjects Or Pass Subjects**, which is applicable, follow the information given on the back-side of the final mark sheet of UG level.*
- In the case of General Graduates (i.e. candidates having graduated without Hons or equivalent), the total marks obtained in general subjects should be entered in the row of Bachelor's degree (General).
- For candidates with less than 50% marks in the honours degree, the total marks of pass and Honours subjects will be considered. If it becomes 50% or more, that score will be entered in the Graduation (General) row. Such a candidate will be treated as a pass graduate.

*****Note:** *Candidates should carefully calculate the percentage of marks and scores against the percentage of marks obtained. Any mistake identified at any point during admission or even during the continuation of the programme may lead to the cancellation of candidature.*

8. Special notes for deputed candidates :

1. *For Deputed Candidates admission will be as per Govt. order no. 372-EDN(CS)/10 M-20/2015 dated 08/06/2023*

- *Following additional documents are required to be submitted positively on the day of joining the B.Ed. programme :*

- i) Release order from the Headmaster / Headmistress.
- ii) Attested copy of M.C. resolution with regards to his/her deputation, countersigned by D.I of Schools (Secondary).
- iii) Certificate from Competent Authority whether the candidate teaches in Class VI or above.
- iv) Three copies of passport size photographs of the applicant.
- v) Deputation form duly filled in (available from the Institution after admission)
- vi) A certificate with the following information is to be submitted from the Secretary or Headmaster/Headmistress (where he/she is serving) and countersigned by the D.I. of Schools of the District concerned:
 - o Certified that the School is in receipt of aid on full/ deficit/ lump sum grant basis or that the school is unaided or under salary deficit scheme one.
 - o Certified that she/he is a duly approved teacher.
 - o Certified that she/he is being deputed by the school for undergoing a two-year B.Ed. Course (2023-25)
 - o Candidates pursuing any other course in the The Baba Sahed Ambedkar Education University or any other University during 2023-25 academic sessions are not eligible for admission to the B. Ed. programme for the session 2023-25.

2. Reservations:

- Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/PWD (**Minimum disability 40%**) candidates will be as per Govt. Rules. Relaxation of minimum qualifying marks will be as per Govt. rules. Unfilled seats reserved for deputed teachers may be de-reserved for fresher candidates, with prior approval of the concerned authority if those remain vacant after counseling

3. General Rules

- School subjects of teaching offered are those which have been mentioned in the New Curriculum of BSAEU:
- Admission to the B.Ed. program is provisional. If any discrepancy is found and detected in the uploaded mark sheets at the time of verification with the originals, the admission shall stand cancelled.

4. After admission, all the candidates are required to get Registration (Online) under the The Baba Sahed Ambedkar Education University.

Candidates should upload the following documents: -

- Recent Color Photo(size 20 Kb to 50 Kb)
- Age- Proof certificate
- All the Mark-sheets, Caste Certificate and PH. Certificate
- All the Service Documents (for Deputed / In-service Teacher only) SSC Recommendation , MC Resolution , Copy of the Approval from D.I. of Schools

5. Course fee Total – 80,000/- (At the Time of Admission Students will pay (i) Rs.40, 000/- for the first year (2023) payable at the time of admission and (ii) Rs.40, 000/- for the second year (2024) ; Total amount payable isRs.80,000/-
