The development of any organization, especially an educational institution, heavily depends upon a wellfunctioning feedback system. It requires a thorough preparation to initiate, launch and implement the feedback system. This institution has been practicing a feedback system accommodating all the stakeholders including students, staff, employer, parents, alumni to help the individuals and organization as a whole, to improve the performance and effectiveness.

1.Students' Feedback Report

For the academic year 2019 to 2021, students' feedback is sought from 41 students about the curriculum. Majority of the student population (81%) agreed that the curricular area is very much challenging and the allocation of credits is appropriate in relation to the level of course work. The curriculum is very good- opined 28% of the students. Many others (62%) accepted the curriculum as a good one. Co curricular activities form the most important component of a teacher education programme. More than 81% students expressed their high satisfaction with the co curricular activities organised in this college. Almost 78 % of the students strongly agreed that that the syllabus is covered by the teachers on time and the quality of teaching-learning is very good. Again, very close to 85% of the students are highly satisfied with the facilities available from the library. More than 60% of the college has been of much satisfaction with 90% of the students. Even for the rest 14% the infrastructure is satisfactory. The graphical representation of the responses of the students in different parameters are given below.


