## **Report of the Placement Cell**

The placement cell of Siliguri B.Ed. College was formally established in the meeting of IQAC dated 20.08.2022 for the benefit of the trainees of the college with an aim to provide various relevant information and guidance for career development and achieving career goals. It was made functional in the first meeting of the cell dated 25.08.2022. But informally it has been running from the very beginning of the starting of the college. Our institution took initiatives to make contact with the different Govt. and Non Govt. private schools so that our passed out trainees may be appointed there as teachers. Many of our trainees have been recommended and ultimately placed also by our principal and faculties in different reputed schools.

The major activities of the proposed cell include:

- 1) Orientation by resource persons
- 2) Interaction with the owners of institutions/ organizations
- Providing information for vacancies through print and digital media or providing direct information
- 4) Organizing campus interview
- 5) Organizing training program on demand
- 6) Any other that may be required

## The portal for the placement cell was developed in the college website on 22.08. 2022.

## The following initiatives has been taken so far by the Placement Cell of our college:

 Our faculty members have taken free remedial classes on the basis of requirements of our trainees for appearing NET, TET, and SACT etc. Special classes were taken by our faculties from 5.11.2022 to 6.12.2022 online without any extra remuneration.

- Various private schools in Siliguri conducted interviews in our campus in which some alumni have been recruited. Examples are Modi Public School, Pranavananda Centenary School, BSF School and others.
- 3. An agreement (MOU) was done with RICE (Roy's institute of Comparative Examination Pvt. Ltd.) which is a premier institution to help trainees to reach the desired career goal.
- 4. At the same time, the placement cell arranges free coaching from the college before various teacher recruitment examinations.
- 5. One WhatsApp group was created with the Principal, Faculties, final year trainees and extrainees who registered in the placement cell, in which vacancy positions at various schools, colleges and other Govt. jobs are posted at a regular basis.
- 6. Soft copies of newspaper related to employment status and position for example Employment News, Karmasansthan, etc. are regularly posted in the group.
