3. Community Awareness on COVID Pandemic

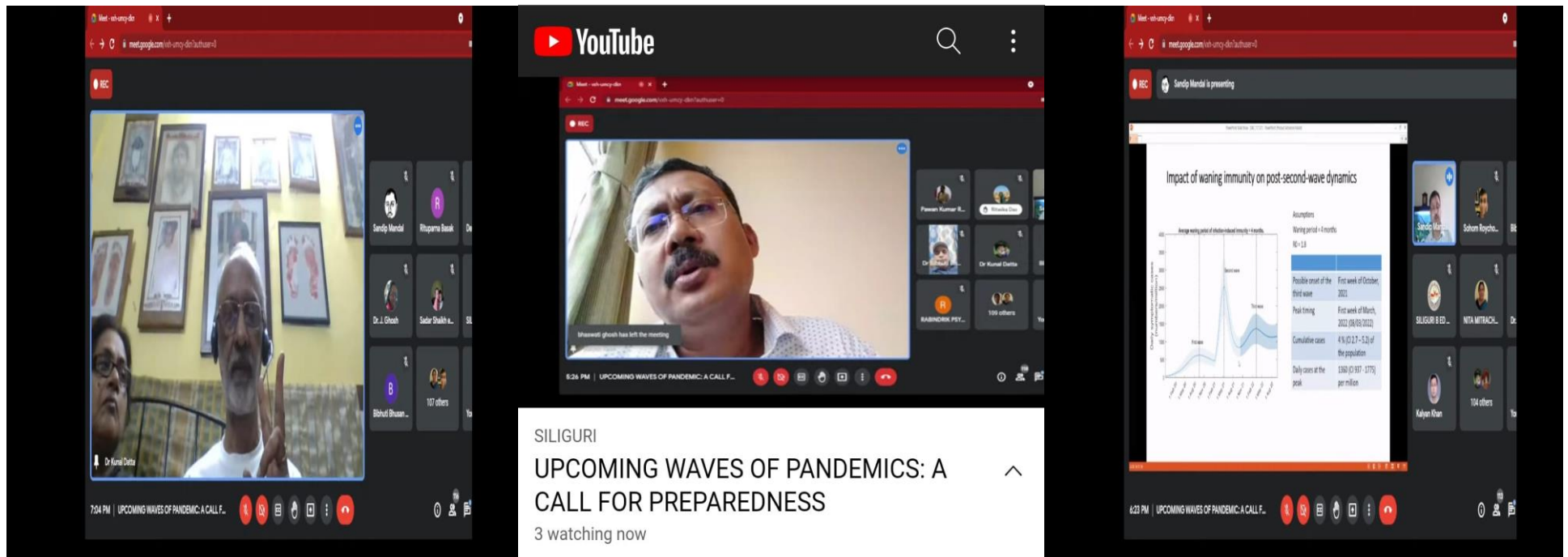

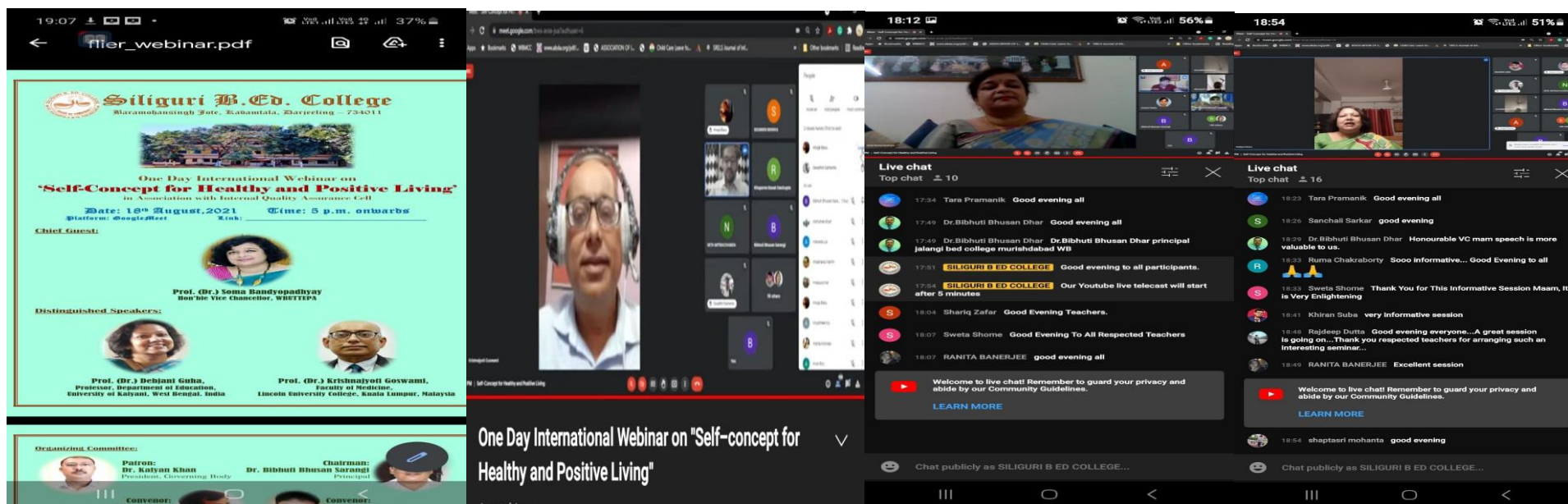
1. National level webinar on Upcoming waves of Pandemics: A Call for Preparedness

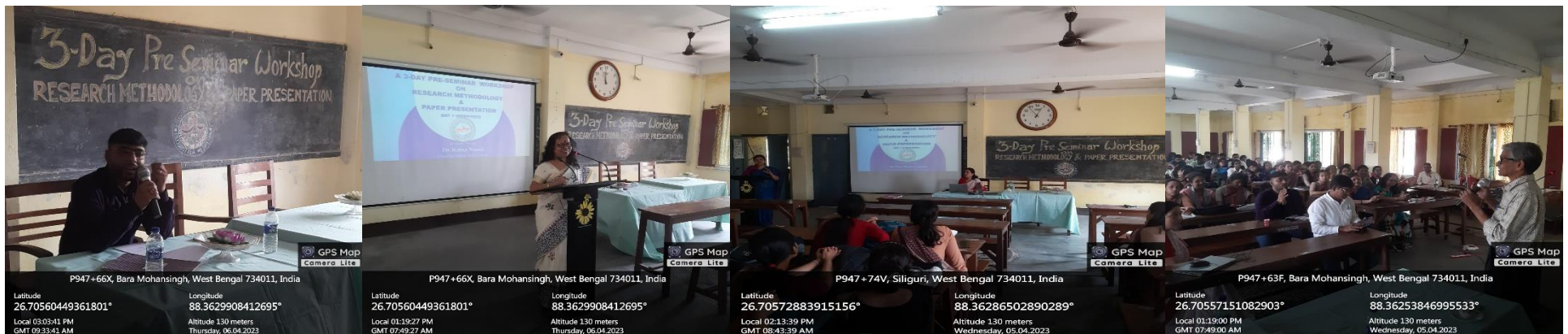
6th April 2023
